STUDENT CODE OF BEHAVIOUR - SOCIALS

Dear Parents/Carers and Students

Wingham High School SRC will continue to hold school socials in the Multipurpose Centre (MPC). School staff will be in attendance and provide supervision so that everyone can have an enjoyable time. Consideration is also given to the hiring of professional security to patrol the school grounds and surrounding area to increase the safety of students attending the social.

All students wishing to attend a school social are required to accept the following conditions of entry into the function and venue. Read these carefully:

- 1. students must be currently enrolled at Wingham High School
- 2. students are to purchase a ticket for the social from the SRC in the designated area and time frame. Ticket sales are the Friday, Monday and Tuesday prior to the social. NO TICKETS will be sold on the Wednesday of the Social
- 3. students who have been suspended or who are on a discipline card or truancy card at the time of the social are not permitted to attend
- 4. students must be present at school on the day of the social
- 5. students who know they will be a little late because of training commitments (etc) must indicate this to the SRC coordinator selling the tickets AND be accompanied to the MPC door by a parent/carer no later than 7:00pm
- 6. students who need to leave early need to make prior arrangement with the SRC Coordinator AND will need to be met at the door by a parent/carer
- 7. bags brought to the venue will be stored in a separate area and will not be accessible during the social
- 8. local police will be advised of the event and may visit

9. Students agree:

- to show respectful and responsible behaviour at all times
- NOT to consume alcohol, cigarettes or illegal substances, either before or during the school function
- 10. <u>Senior students</u>: intending to transport students in a vehicle to and from the event, must inform the deputy of your intentions by providing in writing:
 - driver's name, the passenger list, your licence number and the car registration details
 - permission notes for the driver and passengers to the Deputy Principal
- 11. Students who have to be ejected from the social and collected by parents for any reason will be dealt with:
 - through the normal channels of the School Discipline System
 - banned from socials for 12 months

<u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: This form will only be issued ONCE. If you want to attend a social this year, you MUST return the form to your roll teacher by the end of Term 1. No record of the form being returned means that you are forfeiting your right to attend ANY social for the year.
